Adult Volunteer Information

In order for the youth group to be active and participate in many activities it is essential to have the support of parents and other interested adults. Adult volunteers are needed to chaperone, drive to off-site events, prepare food, assist in planning activities, and to help as it is needed. The goal is to have enough interested adult volunteers that it does not become a burden, but rather enjoyable for the adults too.

To be an adult volunteer for the high school youth group you must complete two things:

1. "Shield the Vulnerable" is the program the Archdiocese requires for all volunteers to participate in youth events. "Shield the Vulnerable" is a web based presentation with questions and answers. When signing up please specify St. Michael the Archangel in Overlea as the parish. This takes about 40 minutes to complete. The link to the web site is:

2. Volunteers must get approval from the Archdiocese to drive for youth group events. To get approved you must fill out the Driving Record Consent Form and email it to Chanan Lewis at chanan.lewis@archbalt.org.
