## **PLANNING MEETING: THURSDAY, MARCH 3 @ 7:00 P.M.**

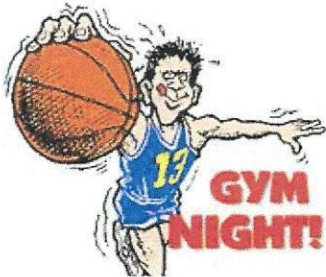
This meeting is for the planning committee and any parents, who would like to assist in planning and implementing youth group events. We will meet in the parish office.

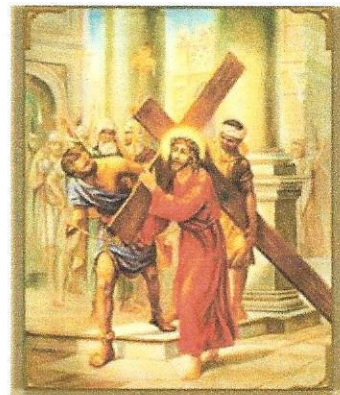
## **OPEN GYM NIGHT FRIDAY, MARCH 11 7:30 – 9:30 P.M.**

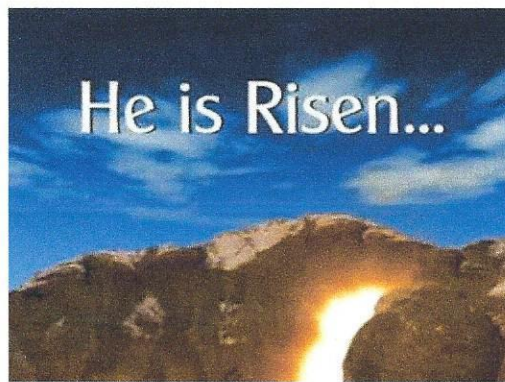


**ANNUAL YOUTH PILGRIMAGE**

## **YOUTH & FAMILY MASS POT LUCK LUNCH SUNDAY, APRIL 17 11:30 A.M.**

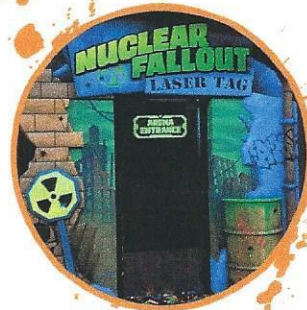
