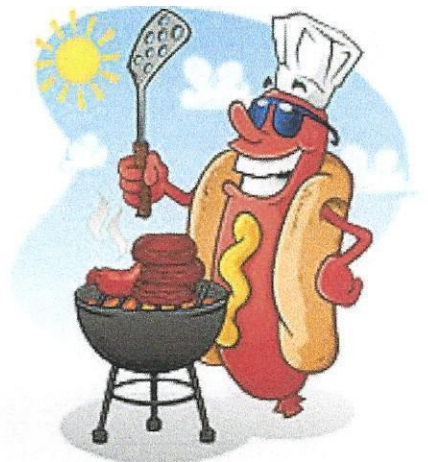

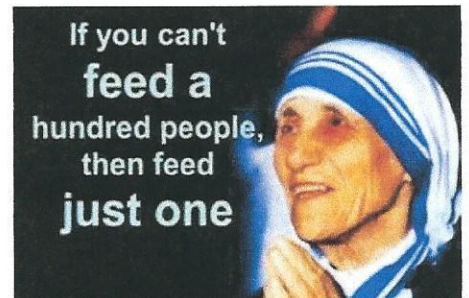

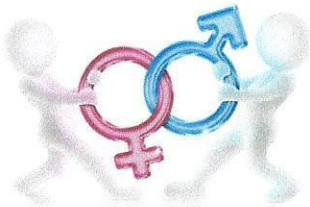
Our Daily Bread

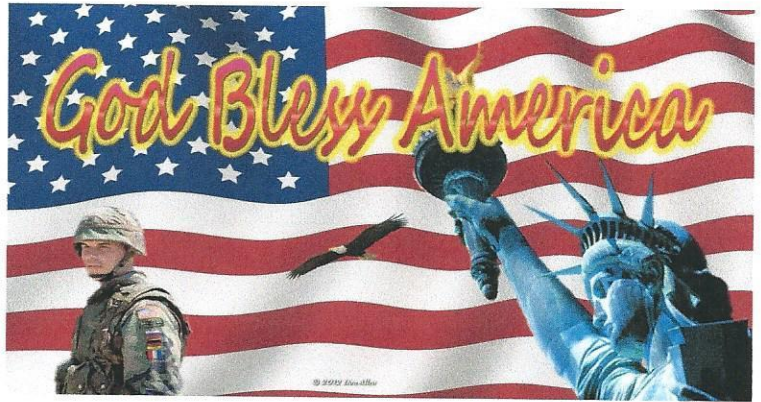
Topic Night – Battle of the Sexes

Crafts for Santa's Castle

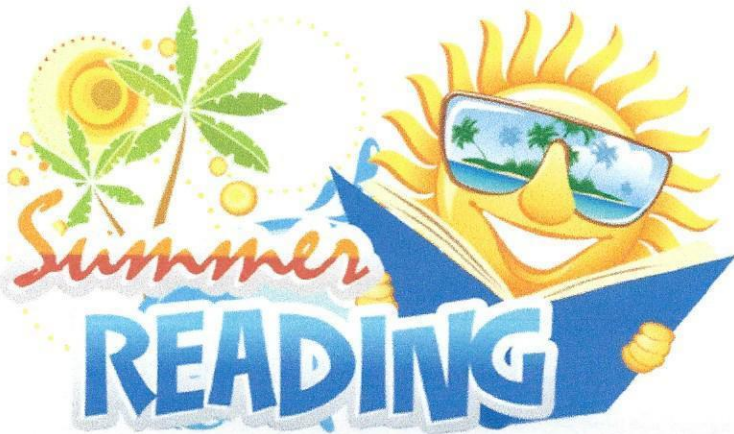

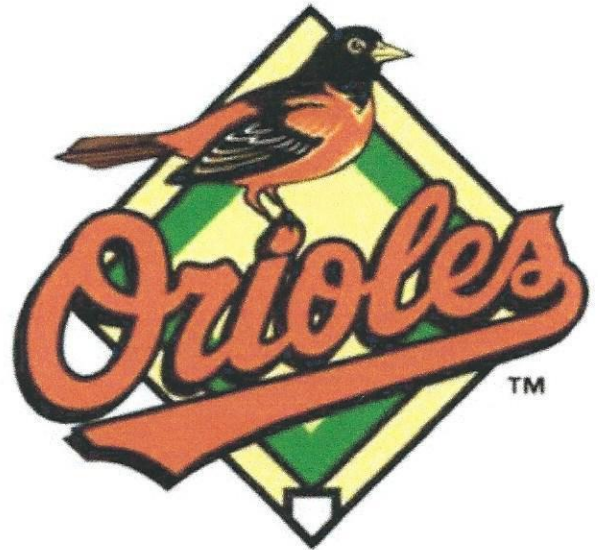
